

- Personality Test
- Timed
- Multiple Sections

- Go with your gut
- Be passionate
- Don't think too hard!

Phone Interview

- Approxiamately 20 minutes
- Write down your recruiter's name!
- Independent living
- Have your top 5 roles ready
- Review general questions

- Never be afraid to ask them to repeat the question
- Have (good!) questions prepared to ask your recruiter at the end
- Thank them for their time (use their name!)
